

# To North Cornwall District Council regarding a wind farm proposal

**Dear Planning Officer**

I wish to **object** to the following wind farm proposal and associated infrastructure in North Cornwall:

- **Application No. 2007/01497 LAND AT, TITCH BARROW, DAVIDSTOW** - Wind energy development comprising the erection of four wind turbines each with a maximum overall height of up to 120 metres together with access tracks, hard standing areas, information board, electricity sub-station, temporary construction compound and alterations to vehicular access on land to the south of the A39 to the north of Davidstow

This wind farm will cause unacceptable damage to:

- the landscape and visual amenity of communities across the whole of the North Cornwall area, with associated impacts on existing local businesses that are tourism dependent.
- the noise amenity of communities in the areas affected by these proposals, as well as the wider North Cornwall area - an integral and important part of local life and valued by visitors.
- the cultural heritage of North Cornwall, including archaeological sites.

**I further object on the following grounds:**

- There are already two operational wind farms close to this proposed new development. The Cornwall Energy Study recommends a 7km buffer zone around existing wind farms.
- Health and Safety: the close proximity to A39 'Atlantic Highway' of this proposed development, will pose a danger to traffic by shadow flicker from the blades and accident and injury from the turbines themselves, due to structural failure as can be caused by high winds or lightning.
